GIVING

1. REASONS TO GIVE

A. Giving is one way to show love.

God wanted to show us how much He loved us. He chose to give us the greatest Gift in heaven.

Who is this Gift? John 3:16; 2 Corinthians 9:15

What did Jesus Christ give up for us because He loved us? Philippians 2:5-8



We love God because He first loved us, 1 John 4:19. Those who truly love will want to give. When we truly love God, we will want to give to Him.

B. Giving brings thankfulness and praise to God.

2 Corinthians 9:7-11. (N.L.T.)

Each man should give as he has decided in his heart. He should not give, wishing he could keep it. Or he should not give if he feels he has to give. God loves a man who gives because he wants to give. God can give you all you need. He will give you more than enough. You will have everything you need for yourselves. And you will have enough left over to give when there is a need. . . . It is God Who gives seed to the man to plant. He also gives bread to eat. Then we know He will give you more seed to plant and make it grow so you will have more to give away. God will give you enough so you can always give to others. Then many will give thanks to God for sending gifts through us.

C. Giving returns to God what belongs to Him.

• All that we have comes from God.

Sometimes we hear people say, "We have worked hard for what we have. We do not HAVE to give it away". To better understand what God wants us to give, let us see what He did for us.

What does Deuteronomy 8:17,18 say about this?

Read 1 Chronicles 29:14. Who gives us all things?

To whom do our bodies belong? 1 Corinthians 6:19,20

It is true that what we have has been lent to us. We are to give it back to God. We are to use it to bring honor and glory to Him.

Because has made us, we should also give Him our life. Psalm 100:3.

Why should we return things to God?

• Stewardship.

In Bible days a rich man would give his field to one of his workers. The worker would plant that field and take care of it. When the worker would take the crop off the field, he would give the crop back to his boss. This pleased the boss. The workman is the steward. The field is his stewardship. God has given us the ability to do different things. We are stewards of these abilities He has given us. We are to use these abilities to please God.

D. Giving is obeying God's command.

If we obey God and give to Him, what will He do for us? Malachi 3:10

2. WHAT TO GIVE

We should give to God 1) our lives, 2) our bodies, 3) our time, 4) our abilities and 5) our money.

A. Our lives.

To whom do we belong? 1 Peter 1:18,19

B. Our bodies.

When we give ourselves to the Lord, we give Him our bodies, Romans 12:1. Our bodies are to be used to do His work.

C. Our time.

We have many things to do every day. We are busy, yet God wants us to give Him our time. He wants us to take time to read His Word and pray to Him. To teach, train and take care of

our children is also a way that we give time to God. He wants us to tell others about Him. God may ask us to teach the Bible to others. He may want us to go and visit a sick person. There are many things He may ask us to do.

D. Our abilities.

Some people can do one thing well. Other people can do a different thing well. We say, "They have the ability to sing well." or "They have the ability to make good food."

Name some of God's gifts we are to use as we work for Him, Romans 12:6-8.

We should serve God with the abilities He has given us.

E. Our money.

There is one other thing that God wants from us, and that is our money. A person who has given his whole life to the Lord will not find it hard to give his money to the Lord. His money really means much to him because he worked to get it. The giving of money is a very loving thing to do. Paul tells us to put aside some of our money every week, 1 Corinthians 16:2,3.

3. WAYS TO GIVE

There are four different ways in which we are to give. They are: generously, cheerfully, regularly and give God's part.

A. Give generously.

We should be glad to give. We should not be stingy.

In 1 Kings 17:8-16 we read how God took care of a widow lady.

B. Give cheerfully.

We should be happy because we have a chance to give to God. It is something special we can do for Him.

How does God feel about a cheerful giver? 2 Corinthians 9:7

C. Give regularly.

When we give regularly, we give a certain amount of money every week or every month. This depends on how often we get our pay. If we give regularly, we form a habit of giving. Then we do not forget to give.

What does Paul tell us to do in 1 Corinthians 16:2?

D. Give God's part.

This means to give a certain part of our money to the Lord. We will give according to what we have earned or received. In other words, if we get ten dollars, we give the Lord one dollar. If we get twenty dollars, we give Him two dollars. This is what God is really asking us to do. It is called "tithing." Abraham tithed before the Law was given to Moses, Genesis 14:17-20. This is the smallest amount we should give to God. When we see what He has done for us, we certainly should want to do more for Him.
