

LESSON 7

LIVING IN VICTORY

The Bible tells us the Christian life is like running a race. There are many that run in a race, but only one receives the prize. 1 Corinthians 9:24-27 tells us to fight to win in the Christian life. When we say a person wins we can say he gets the victory. He defeats those who run against him. We see this in dog-team races or canoe races. We see it in weight-lifting. We see it in fighting. Whoever is able to do better than the other person wins the victory. Paul said,



"I have fought a good fight, I have finished the work I was to do. I have kept the faith." 2 Timothy 4:7 (N.L.T.).

Paul won the victory. Many new Christians soon get discouraged because they think the Christian life is like a nice soft bed to lie upon. They think that all they have to do is to wait for heaven. When we trust Christ as our Saviour, we are saved from going to hell. We have also started a new life. In this new life there is suffering.


What kind of life does Philippians 1:29,30 say we have?

The Christian life that wins is a life that lives close to God. This new life is able to overcome sin and the devil by the power of Christ.

1. WHAT WE FIGHT

A. We fight the flesh.

We must remember our old self life wants us to sin. This self life is called "the flesh" in the Bible. The new life we receive from God wants us to be like the Lord Jesus Christ. We have two desires within us. One desire is to keep on sinning. The other desire is to be like Christ. So we see that we have a fight right inside of us. An old Indian chief once said, "We have two dogs in us. A white dog and a black dog. They want to fight each other." See Romans 7:14-25.

What happens in the new life? Philippians 1:29

A. We fight for victory.

B. We fight for a reward.

3. HOW WE CAN FIGHT

Many times people are afraid to become Christians because they think they will not be able to stop sinning.

How can we keep from sinning? 2 Corinthians 2:14

We have everything we need to live a victorious life. There are seven things which we can use as we fight against the devil. These are: 1) God's help, 2) prayer, 3) our new life, 4) the Word of God, 5) to stay away from the things of the world, 6) God's weapons, and 7) the power of Christ.

A. We fight with God's help.

It is true, no person is strong enough to win victories over sin or over the devil. Someone must help us.

Who sets us free from sin? Romans 8:2

Who keeps us from the evil one? 2 Thessalonians 3:3

The Spirit of life, that is, the Holy Spirit has set us free from the power of sin and death. The Lord keeps us from the evil one.

B. We fight with prayer.

Prayer is one of the strongest things we have to fight with. It gives us the power we need to say "no" to temptation.

When we have a desire to do something sinful, we are to tell ourselves, "I am dead to the power of sin. I am now living for Christ", Galatians 2:20. We must believe that Jesus broke the power of sin when He died, Romans 6:10,11. Ask the Holy Spirit to help you to really understand this.



G. We fight with the power of Jesus Christ.


The devil will try to scare us. He wants us to think that he is strong enough to take us away from God. Nothing is stronger than God's love.
