
B. Jehoram, 2 Kings 3:1-27.


A. Jehu, 2 Kings 9:1 - 10:36; 2 Chronicles 22:7-9.

Ahab's family became very wicked. They made the people of Israel worship Baal. God had to destroy them. God chose Jehu to destroy this family. Jehu killed more than the Lord asked him to kill. He killed the sons of Ahaziah, king of Judah (2 Chronicles 22:8).

Jehu broke down the idols of Baal and killed the priests of





Baal. He killed most of the people who worshipped Baal.




B. Joash, also called Jehoash, 2 Kings 11:4-12, 17-21; 12:1-21; 2 Chronicles 23:1 - 24:27.


READ 2 KINGS 12:1-21; 2 Chronicles 24:18-27.

11:21)?


Who helped him rule Judah (2 Kings 12:2)?

Jehoash of Israel died fifteen years before Amaziah died.





What did the people of Israel do to make the Lord angry (2 Kings 17:8-12)?





1. besiege - to surround a place or city with an army. The army will not let any food go into the city. The army waits till the people get so hungry that they give in to those who besiege them.
