

MARK 1:1-15



God wanted the Gospel of Mark to be written. He used a man whose name was John Mark to write it for Him. Mark was born in Jerusalem. We do not know his father's name. His mother's name was Mary, (Acts 12:12). In his book, Mark shows Jesus was a Servant of God. A servant is someone who works for a master (boss). Jesus worked for His Father, God. Jesus wants us to work for God also. We are to be "servants for Jesus' sake" (2 Corinthians 4:5). In Matthew 10:25 it tells us that "it is enough for the servant to be like his Lord." If we want to be like Jesus, we must study the Bible to see what Jesus is like.

READ MARK 1:1-11



Jesus and John the Baptist were cousins. Their mothers, Mary and Elizabeth, were cousins. John was only 6 months older than Jesus. He did not know that Jesus was the Son of God till he baptized Him. God told John who Jesus was. John saw the Holy Spirit come down on Jesus. This was one way that God showed John who Jesus really was. (Read John 1:32-34.) John never forgot that day!
