Every verse in the Bible has something important to say to us. The Bible is God's Word. Let us see what God is saying in these five verses.


## 1. **JESUS WALKED**. (verse 16)

Jesus asks us to leave our old sinful ways. He wants to give us a new way that is much better. When we do not trust Him with all our hearts, we will hold to our old way. We will miss the good new way Jesus wants to give us. Jesus loves us. He wants us to give ourselves to Him. Jesus sees what our hearts are really like. He even knows what we think. He wants to come into our lives and make our hearts clean and new. (Read Revelation 3:20 and 2 Corinthians 5:17.) When our hearts are clean and new, we will want to follow Jesus. We will want to follow Jesus more than anything else.
