READ MARK 1:21-31

As soon as anyone starts to follow Jesus, Jesus begins to teach him. Jesus wants His follower to know Him. He wants him to know Jesus has the right and the power to do and say what He does and says.



A teacher has the right to tell the children what to do. He has the power to make the children obey. We say the teacher has the **authority** to do this.

Jesus wants to teach His followers that He has authority to teach and to do miracles.




