LEPROSY


In hot countries people sometimes get a very bad disease. This disease is called leprosy. In Bible times there was no cure for leprosy.



When a person has leprosy, his skin turns white in spots. The person cannot feel anything where the spots are. The white spots often turn into sores. These sores may not heal. After a while the hands and feet may become deformed. The person who has leprosy is called a leper.

In Bible times everybody was afraid of a leper. The leper had to live by himself. If anyone came near him, he had to cry out, "Unclean! Unclean!" The leper was very lonely and sad. Even his own children could not touch him. Nobody would touch him or go near him. Everybody was afraid they would catch the disease. No doctor could heal leprosy. There was no hope for the leper.

Sin is like leprosy. Sin is even worse. Leprosy separated a man from other people. Sin separates us from God. Sin is unclean, and makes our hearts filthy. (Read Mark 7:21-23.) No doctor can operate and take away our sin. No man can help us. Only God can help us. God sent His Son to die for us and to take away our sin.




When we confess our sin,
"The blood of Jesus Christ, his (God's) Son, cleanseth us from all sin."

(1 John 1:7)

The leper came to Jesus and asked Him for help. Jesus touched him and made him well and clean. We can come to Jesus and ask Him to forgive us. We can trust Him to touch our lives. Jesus will make us clean from **all** sin.

When a leper was made clean from his disease, he would never, never want that bad disease again. When Jesus makes our hearts clean from sin we should never, never want that old sin again.
