## **MARK 3:6-12**

Review: Review the last lesson about who the Pharisees and the Herodians were.

## **READ MARK 3:6-12**

**Choose** the best answers in the following:

- 1. The Pharisees and Herodians did not agree about many things, but they did agree on one thing. They wanted to (put Jesus in prison, kill Jesus, send Jesus out of the country) (verse 6)
- 2. Jesus knew that the Pharisees and Herodians were His (friends, true followers, enemies) (verse 6)
- 3. The Pharisees and Herodians hated Jesus because He (would not obey their rules, kept the sabbath day, the way they did; was a Jew) (verse 2)
- Jesus could do what the religious leaders could not do. People loved Jesus and followed Him instead of them. The religious leaders (loved Jesus too, respected Jesus, were jealous of Jesus)
- 5. In verse 9, Jesus got into a small boat because: (he wanted to rest, He did not want anybody to touch Him, He wanted to fish, everybody wanted to touch Him at once)
- 6. There was a crowd of people because: (they had problems with sickness and demons, they just wanted to see what was going on, they knew who Jesus really was)

- Jesus healed the people who touched Him: (to see what would happen, because everybody else was doing it, because they had faith)
   . (Read Matthew 9:20-22.)
- 8. Jesus let His power go to work because He was the (verses 10,11)
- 9. When anybody really believed in Jesus, did He really let His power go to work for him? Which verses tell us that?
- 10. Why do **you** think the unclean spirits fell down when they saw Jesus?

The Pharisees and Herodians wanted to kill Jesus and spoil
His good work for the people. The devil used the Pharisees and
Herodians as tools to fight against God.




The devil was working against people. He sent demons to live in some people. He sent sickness to other people. God allowed these things. God wanted the people to know that He was stronger than the devil. The power of God in Jesus is able to overcome the power of the devil. Jesus could fix all the bad Satan tried to do. Jesus cast out the demons, and cured the sick people who believed in Jesus.

Some people let themselves be used as tools for the devil to do his work. Other people let God use them as tools for His work. (Read Romans 6:13.)


God is exactly the opposite of the devil. In the following, fill in the blanks to show how God and Satan are not alike in any way. You may want to make this list longer by thinking of other ways.
