MARK 6:7-13,30,31

Review:

So far the Book of Mark has told us about Jesus. Jesus was baptized. He was tempted by Satan, but He never sinned. Jesus called men to Him. Right away Jesus started to teach His followers many lessons about Himself. Now they know that Jesus has the **POWER** and the **AUTHORITY** to:

- 1. teach.
- 2. cast out demons.
- 3. heal all kinds of sickness.
- 4. make a leper clean.
- 5. forgive sins.
- 6. raise the dead to life.
- 7. tell the big wind to stop blowing.
- 8. make the big waves on the sea to be quiet.

Now Jesus has His men ready to go and tell others what they learned. But just to know about Jesus is not enough. Jesus gives them some of His power to do miracles.

READ MARK 6:7-13

Matthew 10:1-42 tells more about the same story.

- 1. How many disciples did Jesus send out?
- Read verse 7. Then fill in the blanks.

- 12. Read GENESIS 18:20,21 and GENESIS 19:24. The cities of Sodom and Gomorrah were very bad and full of sin.

God destroyed these two cities by from heaven because of their .

Jesus told His followers that some people would not ask them to come in. They would not listen to the Gospel. Jesus said it would be worse for them than for the cities of S and G .
