READ MARK 6:45-56

2. Where did Jesus tell the disciples to go? .

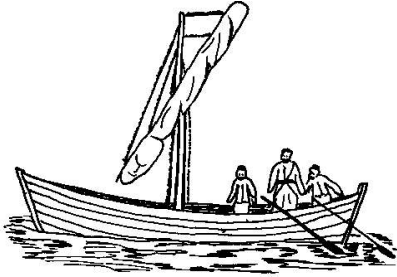
The disciples left. Many thousands of people whom Jesus fed were still there.

7. What did the disciples do in verse 49?

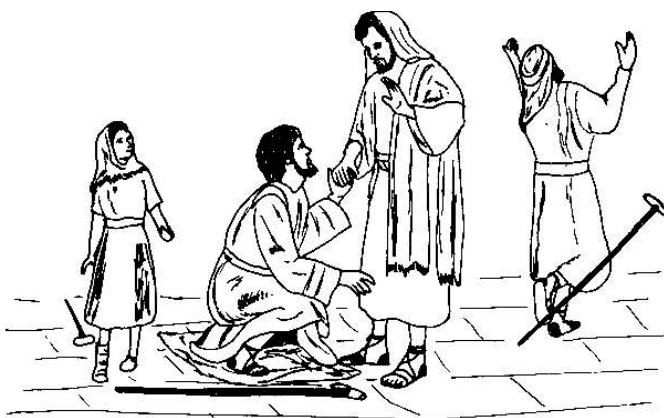
8. Jesus knew how scared the disciples were. When did He talk to them?

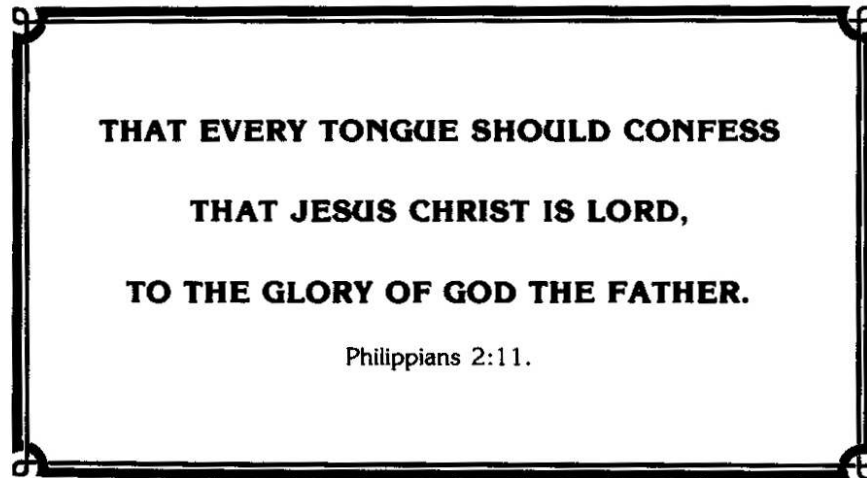
What is happening in the picture?
