#### **READ MARK 9:2-8**

### **JESUS TRANSFIGURED**

These verses seem to give us a little taste of the coming kingdom of God.


Somebody in this story went to heaven without dying. Another got there after he died. The King Himself was present too.

. (Transfigured means changed. Raiment means clothes.)

6. How was Jesus changed? (verse 3) "His raiment became , exceedingly ; so as no on earth can them." (A fuller was a laundry man. His work was to make clothes clean. He sometimes put clothes in a tub with soap and stamped on them with his bare feet. Sometimes he beat them in the water with a stick. Sometimes the fuller made the clothes nice and white by rubbing chalk into them.) Mark 9:3 says that when Jesus was transfigured, no fuller on earth could make

His clothes whiter. They were even shining. 1

- 7. In verse 4, the disciples saw two other men talk with Jesus. Who were these and men?
- 8. Read Deuteronomy 34:5-8. Moses died on a mountain top in Moab. God buried him, and nobody knows where his grave is. The Bible just says that God buried him.

Moses had been dead more than 1,400 years. Moses came back and talked with Jesus on the mountain. The disciples saw him.

- 9. Read 2 Kings 2:9-11. How did Elijah go to heaven? (verse 11)
- 10. Did Elijah die before he went to heaven? (2 Kings 2:11) Elijah had been in heaven more than 800 years. He came back with Moses to talk with Jesus on top of the mountain. Peter and James and John saw Elijah talk with Jesus.
