JESUS CAST OUT A DUMB SPIRIT

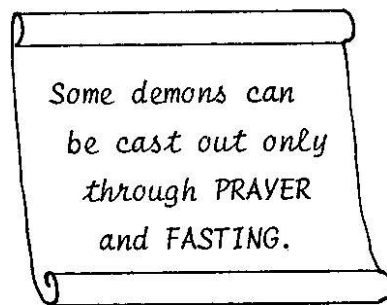
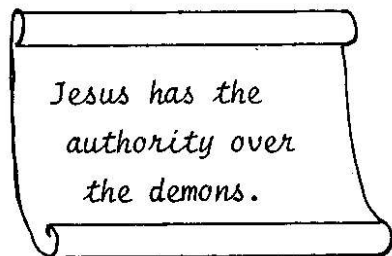
The boy who was brought to Jesus by his father had a dumb spirit living in him. (verse 17) This spirit was a demon. How did the bad spirit bother the boy?
