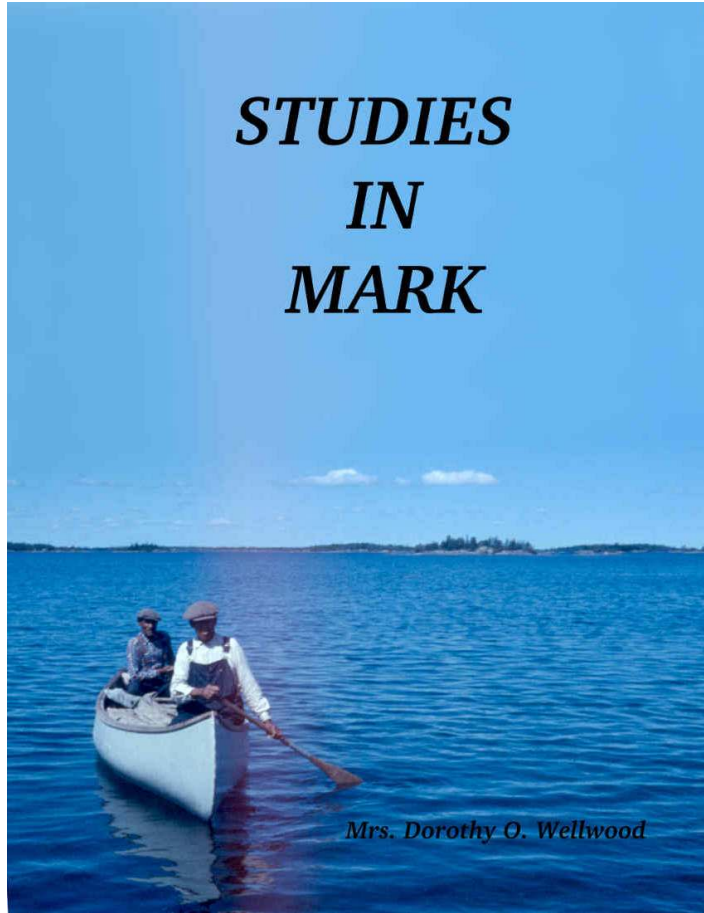

READ MARK 16:9-14

PEOPLE WHO SAW JESUS

Mary

1. In verse 9 we are told that it was the first day of the week. You will remember that this was our Sunday. A most wonderful thing happened on that day. It was the day that Jesus rose from the dead.
Who was the first person to see Jesus after He came alive? . (verse 9)
2. What miracle had Jesus done for this woman? .
3. John's Gospel tells us that she was by the tomb crying. She had loved Jesus very much. Why was she crying? . (John 20:13)

Sometimes we are like Mary. We are crying when we should be full of joy. Jesus had promised the disciples that He would rise from the dead on the third day and this was the third day. God has given us many promises in His Bible. When we believe them, we will be filled with joy instead of sadness.

4. Jesus did not want Mary Magdalene to cry. He asked her some questions. READ John 20:15. What two questions did Jesus ask Mary?
 - 1) Why ?
 - 2) Whom ?
5. This man who was talking to Mary Magdalene did not tell her who He was. He simple called her by name. When this man spoke her name, she suddenly knew Jesus was talking to her. Now instead of being in tears, Mary was happy. This is what Jesus loves to do for those who love Him and believe Him. What had He told them in John 15:11? .”

6. Mary ran and told the disciples that Jesus was alive. Were they happy? (Mark 16:11) . Why?

The two on the road.

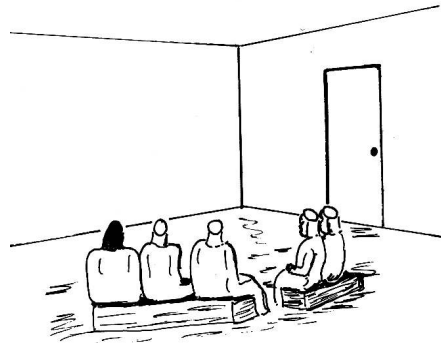
1. What two people saw Jesus next? (verse 12)

READ this beautiful story about the two who walked with Jesus as they went down the road to their home. The story is in Luke 24:13-32. When they knew that it was Jesus who had walked with them, they rushed back to Jerusalem to tell the other disciples. Did the disciples believe them?



The disciples

1. Jesus had sent the women to tell the disciples that He had risen from the dead just as He said He would. But the disciples went on being sad instead of happy. Then Jesus sent the two he walked with on the road. Still they were sad. Why were they still sad? Unbelief always makes people sad.



2. At last Jesus came to those faithless disciples. What were they doing when Jesus appeared to them? (verse 14)

3. In verse 14, Jesus **upbraided** the disciples. This means He was not pleased with His disciples. Because of their _____ and _____ of _____ .

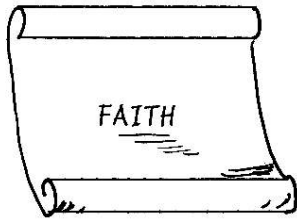
Is Jesus pleased with us when we do not believe all that He has told us in His Word?

FAITH

God has given us many verses in His Word about believing what He says. Let us look up some of these verses about believing:

1) MATTHEW 21:22

“And all things whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer,



2) MARK 9:23

“ . . . all things are possible to him that believeth.”

3) LUKE 8:49,50

“ . . . Thy daughter is dead . . . But when He heard it, He answered him saying, Fear not, and believe only that thy daughter shall live.”

4) JOHN 1:12

“But as many as received Him, to them gave He power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe in His name.”

5) JOHN 3:15

“That whosoever believeth in Him, should not perish, but have everlasting life.”

6) JOHN 3:36

“He that believeth not on the Son of man hath eternal life not abiding in him, but the wrath of God abideth on him.”

HOW CAN WE KNOW FOR SURE THAT JESUS REALLY CAME TO LIFE AFTER HIS ENEMIES PUT HIM TO DEATH?

We studied in the last lesson a number of things which prove that Jesus came to life again. These are:

1. **The tomb was empty.** (Mark 16:4)
2. **The (enemies of Jesus) soldiers said Jesus had risen.** (Matthew 28:11-15)
3. **The angels said Jesus had risen from the dead.** (Mark 16:5-6)
4. **Jesus was seen by many people.**
