
2. Jesus is a priest in the order of Melchizedek.

Jesus and Melchizedek are alike in that:

- They did not come from the tribe of Levi.
- They are called "priest forever."
- They are greater than Abraham.

Who is a priest?

3. A priest is a man who stands between God and man and prays to a holy God for guilty sinners. In the Old Testament, a priest would make a sacrifice when he wanted to pray for people who had sinned. **Read** Leviticus chapters four and five.

Leviticus 5:5.6

When anyone is guilty in any of these ways, he must confess in what way he has sinned and, as a penalty for the sin he has committed, he must bring to the LORD a female lamb or goat from the flock as a sin offering; and the priest shall make atonement for him for his sin.

If a person was too poor to bring a lamb, he would bring two doves and two pigeons or some fine flour.

The person who sinned had to confess his sin, and bring a sacrifice. Then the priest would make atonement for the person who had sinned.

What did the priest have to offer before sin could be forgiven?	

4. The priest had to make a sacrifice. The priests used lambs, bulls, doves, and pigeons. Jesus is a priest and He made a sacrifice for sin.

Hebrews 9:26

Then Christ would have had to suffer many times since the creation of the world. But now he has appeared once for all at the end of the ages to do away with sin by the sacrifice of himself.



5. Jesus gave Himself as a sacrifice. The priests had to make sacrifices many times.

Hebrews 9:12

He did not enter by means of the blood of goats and calves; but he entered the Most Holy Place once for all by his own blood, having obtained eternal redemption.

6. Jesus Christ made a sacrifice for sin once.

So Christ was sacrificed once to take away the sins of many people; and he will appear a second time, not to bear sin, but to bring salvation to those who are waiting for him.

7. The sacrifice of Christ takes away the sins of many people. In the Old Testament, the priests also had to make sacrifices for their own sin.

Leviticus 4:3

If the anointed priest sins, bringing guilt on the people, he must bring to the LORD a young bull without defect as a sin offering for the sin he has committed.

- 1 Peter 2:22.24

He committed no sin, and no deceit was found in his mouth. He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness; by his wounds you have been healed.

9. Jesus did no sin, and therefore He did not have to die for His own sin. He died for the sins of people.

God is holy. There is no sin in Him.

"And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, is the LORD of hosts; the whole earth is full of his glory," Isaiah 6:3 (KJV)

Jesus is the Mediator - because He died for the sins of all people

"For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man, Christ Jesus, who gave Himself a ransom for all," 1 Timothy 2:5 (KJV)


People have sinned. They cannot come to the holy God as they are. Their sins need to be forgiven. When a person admits, confesses his sin, and asks Jesus to forgive him, Jesus will do that. Then the person can come to the holy God through Jesus Christ.

"Having therefore a great high priest who has passed into the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession. For we have not a high priest who cannot have compassion on our infirmities, but one tried as we are in all things except sin. Let us therefore draw near with confidence to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need." Hebrews 4:14-16 (KJV)

10. The work of Jesus Christ as High Priest was as a sacrifice and now as an intercessor. Jesus died so sinners



could be forgiven. He does more than this. Jesus is also an intercessor. An intercessor is one who prays for another, as a go-between two people.
