

WEEK 10: THE BLESSINGS OF FOLLOWING JESUS
DAY 1: BLESSINGS ON EARTH

1. We are beginning our last week of lessons in this book. You have been learning many things. You have done well to come so far. Last week we learned we should work for God.

2. I hope that you are already beginning to work for God. Some think God is a very hard person. They think he asks us to do hard things and gives us nothing for our work. But this is not true.

Hebrews 6:10

God is not unjust; he will not forget your work and the love you have shown him as you have helped his people and continue to help them.

Galatians 6:9

Let us not be weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up.

What will happen if we work for God?

3. We will reap a harvest. When we think about a harvest, we think about blessings. Blessings are the good things God gives. Many people think God only gives blessings in heaven. They forget that many blessings are promised to us now on earth. Maybe your friend brought a gift. This gift was wrapped. You wondered what it was.

God tells us about his blessings. Today we will learn about the blessings which he has promised. They are joy and peace and the things we need.

Take your Bible now and read Luke 18:29,30. When can we receive blessings from God?

4. We will receive blessings in heaven. We also receive blessings now. We receive them in this world. Jesus promises us joy when we obey him.

John 15:10,11

If you obey my commands, you will remain in my love, just as I have obeyed my Father's commands and remain in his love. I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete.

Jesus wants us to have joy. This is the first blessing which he gives us. Today we hear much about the good life of rich people or the exciting life in the city. But there is no life which has joy like the life in Jesus. It is a better life. It is everlasting life which is full of joy now.

To whom does Jesus promise to give joy?

5. He gives it to those who obey him. You remember that Jesus sent out seventy disciples one day.

Luke 10:17

The seventy (two) returned with joy. . . .

What does God give as a blessing to those who obey Jesus?

6. He gives joy. This does not mean that the way of Jesus is always easy. Sometimes there are hard times. But even during hard times there is joy in our hearts. David wrote about the joy of those who love God. Isaiah also wrote about it.

Isaiah 12:3

With joy you will draw water from the wells of salvation.

Psalms 16:11

You have made known to me the path of life; you will fill me with joy in your presence, with eternal pleasures at your right hand.

Who can give us the greatest joy in life?

7. Jesus does this. He gives it to us as a blessing for obeying him. It is something deep in our hearts. We can have it even when life is difficult and we don't understand what is happening. At the same time, we have peace. This is another blessing which Jesus gives. He gave peace to the disciples, and he gives peace to us now.

John 14:27

Peace I leave with you, my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.

Peace is another blessing. What is the other blessing which God gives?

8. These are the blessings again.

We have joy. One of the reasons why we have joy is that we have peace in our hearts. Some people are always fighting within themselves. Some want what they do not have. Some are afraid of what is ahead of them.

Isaiah 26:3

You will keep in perfect peace him whose mind is steadfast, because he trusts in you.

Who receives the blessing of peace?

9. It is the Christian, or the one who follows Jesus. It is the one who trusts in him. It comes as a blessing here on earth. Jesus said:

John 16:33

I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world.

What is another blessing for following and obeying Jesus which we receive now?

10. Another blessing is peace. We do not have peace just because the way is easy. Jesus said in the world we would have trouble. But we have peace in troubled times because we trust God. We know he is taking care of us and we are not afraid. Our hearts are quiet and peaceful.

Jesus also promised to give us the things we need.

Matthew 6:33

But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.

Luke 6:38

Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you.

Do these verses sound as if someone is suffering?

11. They sound as if someone is receiving many blessings. As we obey God, he blesses us.

Galatians 6:7,9

Do not be deceived: God cannot be mocked. A man reaps what he sows. . . . Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up.

God promises to give us the things we need. What are the other two blessings which he gives us?

12. God blesses us with joy and peace. He also gives us another blessing here on earth. Paul wrote about this.

Philippians 4:19

And my God will meet all your needs according to his glorious riches in Christ Jesus.

From this verse, what will God give us?

13. He will give us everything we need. He will give us the things we ought to have. He will give us much because his riches are great. But this does not mean everything we may want. Sometimes we want things we do not really need. We want them because we love ourselves too much. God will give us enough of the things we need to live. He will give us enough so that we can share with others.

2 Corinthians 9:6-8

Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously. Each man should give what he has decided in his heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work.

God gives blessings of joy and peace. What other blessing does he give?

14. God will give us the things we need. We may think that we will suffer if we give ourselves to God. But he has promised to give us the food and clothes we need. He will give us enough to share with others. He will give us strength to do his work. Paul said that if we plant much we will reap much. Let us work hard to plant the seed of God's Word.

Let us work hard to share the blessings which God gives us.

DAY 2: BLESSINGS IN HEAVEN

1. This week we are learning about the wonderful blessings God gives us.

2. He gives us joy and peace. He gives us the things we need. These are wonderful blessings which we receive when we obey Jesus. These are not the only blessings we receive. These are small when we think of what is waiting for us in heaven. God has great blessings ahead for those who love him.

1 Corinthians 2:9

However, as it is written: "No eye has seen, no ear has heard, no mind has conceived (understood) what God has prepared for those who love him."

For whom has God prepared great blessings?

3. God has prepared great blessings for those who love him. The most important work is to tell people the good news of Jesus. We should tell them about the great blessings he gives.

When we love Jesus we receive blessings here on earth. We will also receive blessings in heaven. Today we will look at four blessings which we will receive. The greatest blessing is that we will live with Christ.

- 1) We will have a new home.
- 2) Our troubles will end.
- 3) We will receive crowns.
- 4) We will live with Christ.

Take your Bible now and read about the new home we will have. Read John 14:1 and 2. Who is preparing a new home for us in heaven?

4. Jesus is preparing a place for us in heaven. It will be a new home for us. We know it will be wonderful because Jesus is preparing it. Some day we will go to this home in heaven.



John 14:2,3:

In my Father's house are many rooms; if it were not so, I would have told you. I am going there to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am.

If we belong to Jesus, he will come for us. We will be with him. What a wonderful day that will be!

Who will receive the blessing of a new home in heaven?

5. Those who believe in Jesus and have received him as Lord and Saviour, will receive a new home in heaven.



Sometimes life is difficult for us here. We have some troubled times in the Christian life. We may have to give up some things we would like to have. But Paul says the things we will receive will be much better. The blessings we receive in heaven will not pass away.

Hebrews 10:34

You sympathized with those in prison and joyfully accepted the confiscation (taking away) of your property, because you knew

that you yourselves had better and lasting possessions.

What is one blessing we will receive?

6. We will have a new home in heaven. That is one blessing. These are the others:

- 2) Our troubles will end.
- 3) We will receive crowns.
- 4) We will live with Christ.

When we reach our wonderful home, our troubles will end. We will have no more trials, temptations, sickness or suffering.

Revelation 21:4

He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away.

Where will our troubles end?

7. This will be in heaven. We will have a life without sin or suffering. It will be very different from life on earth. Paul wrote that we will have a life of glory in heaven.

Romans 8:18

I consider that our present sufferings are not worth comparing with the glory that will be revealed in us.

What will end in heaven?

8. There will be no more troubles in heaven. Instead of having troubles we will live with Christ. One blessing is a new home in heaven.

What is another blessing?

9. Look at these blessings again.

- 1) We will have a new home.
- 2) Our troubles will end.

- 3) We will receive crowns.
- 4) We will live with Christ.

2 Timothy 2:11,12

Here is a trustworthy saying: If we died with him, we will also live with him; if we endure, we will also reign with him. . . .

The Bible says that we will be kings with Jesus in heaven. We cannot understand this, but we believe it. Some day we will receive this blessing.

What do kings sometimes wear on their heads to show their greatness?

10. Kings sometimes wear crowns. The Bible says that God will give crowns to those who come to live with him.



2 Timothy 4:8

Now there is in store for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award to me on that day - and not only to me, but also to all who have longed for his appearing (coming).

From this verse, what kind of crown is prepared for those who look for the coming of Jesus?

11. It is a crown of righteousness. God will bless those who are faithful in trials.

James 1:12

Blessed is the man who perseveres (keeps going) under trial, because when he has stood the test, he will receive the crown of life that God has promised to those who love him.

1 Peter 5:4

And when the Chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the crown of glory that will never fade away.

What blessing will God give to those who overcome trials?

12. He will give crowns. But these crowns are not to make us feel proud.

Revelation 4:10,11

. . . the twenty-four elders fall down before him who sits on the throne, and worship him who lives for ever and ever. They lay their crowns before the throne and say: "You are worthy, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor and power, for you created all things, and by your will they were created and have their being."

What will we do with the crowns we receive in heaven?

13. We will give them to Jesus. We will lay them at his feet to praise him. The greatest blessing is that we will live with Jesus forever. Let us read again the words which Jesus spoke to the disciples.

John 14:3

And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am.

What blessing will we receive?

14. We will live with Jesus forever. We also will receive crowns, which we will give to Jesus. As the church of the Lord Jesus Christ, we are his bride. There will be a great wedding feast in heaven.

Revelation 19:7,9

Let us rejoice and be glad and give him glory! For the wedding of the Lamb has come, and his bride has made herself ready. . . . Then the angel said to me, "Write: 'Blessed are those who are invited to the wedding supper of the Lamb!'" And he added, "These are the true words of God."

Where should a bride live after she is married?

15. She should live with her husband. As the Bride of Christ, we will live with him. Tomorrow we will learn how Christ will return. Paul says that he will come and call us. We will be caught up into the air.

1 Thessalonians 4:17

After that, we who are still alive and are left will be caught up with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And so we will be with the Lord forever.

With whom will we live in heaven?

16. We will live with Jesus. This is the greatest blessing of following him.

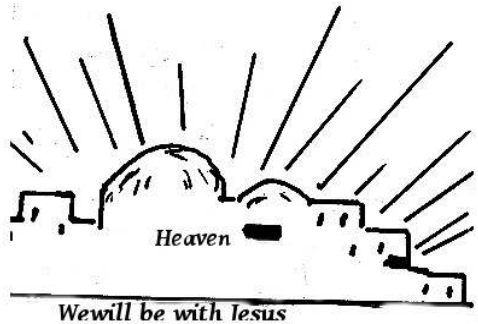

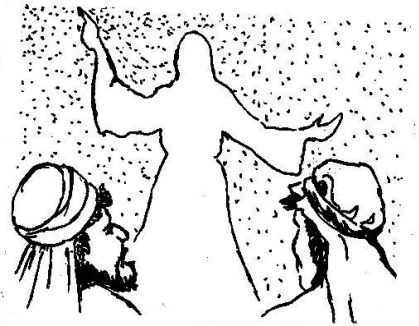
2. The greatest blessing is that we will live with Jesus forever. Other blessings are: We will have a new home, our troubles will end, and we will receive crowns. But when will we receive these blessings? We will receive them when Jesus returns for us. You remember when Jesus left the disciples, he gave them a promise.

John 14:3

And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am.

From this verse, what did Jesus say he will do?

3. Jesus said he will come again and take us to be with him. There are many other verses in the Bible that say Jesus is coming back to earth. Two angels said this to the disciples as Jesus went back to heaven.



Acts 1:11

“Men of Galilee,” they said, “why do you stand here looking into the sky? This same Jesus, who has been taken from you into heaven, will come back in the same way you have seen him go into heaven.”

Some people say Jesus is only coming back as a spirit. How does this verse say he will come?

4. Jesus will come back in the same way as he went into heaven. He will come back in a body, and he will be seen. The Bible tells us how this will happen. Take your Bible now and read 1 Thessalonians 4:16 to 18.

Who will return to take us to be with him?

5. Jesus will return for us. He wants all Christians to be with him.

John 17:24

Father, I want those you have given me to be with me where I am, and to see my glory, the glory you have given me because you loved me before the creation of the world.

When will all Christians go to be with Jesus?

6. We will go to be with Jesus when he comes again.

Matthew 24:36

No one knows about that day or hour, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father.

Who alone knows the time when Jesus will come again?

7. Only the Father knows the time. Jesus will come suddenly when no one is expecting him.

Revelation 3:3

Remember, therefore, what you have received and heard; obey it, and repent. But if you do not wake up I will come like a thief, and you will not know at what time I will come to you.

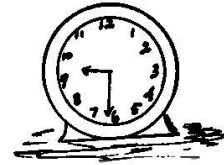
Matthew 24:44

So you also must be ready, because the Son of Man will come at an hour when you do not expect him.

Why do you think God does not tell us when Jesus will return?

8. We will talk about your answer in class.

Let us say it this way, God does not tell us when Jesus is coming because he wants us to be ready all the time. Maybe if people knew when Jesus will come they would be careless. Maybe they would not be faithful while they are waiting.



One day a school inspector visited a school. He said to the students, "I am coming back again. I want to see how well you can take care of your school." A student asked him, "Please sir, which day are you coming?" The inspector answered, "Oh, I won't tell you. I will come suddenly. Then I'll see how well you keep your school all the time."

When will all Christians go to be with Jesus?

9. If we have accepted Jesus as Saviour, we will go with him when he returns. But if we have not accepted him, we won't go with him. We don't know when he will come. We must not become careless. We must be ready.

1 Thessalonians 5:2

...for you know very well that the day of the Lord will come like a thief in the night.

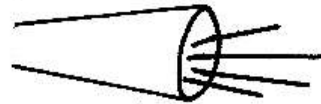
God has told us many things in his word. What has he not told us?

10. He has not told us the time when Jesus will come again.

Why has God not told us when Jesus will come again?

11. God wants us to be ready all the time. He doesn't want us to become careless. If we knew when Jesus will come, we would be tempted to forget our work. We would wait until the time of his coming is near. Then we would hurry to get everything ready.

BE READY !!!



Jesus told the disciples that he was going away. He said he was like a master going on a trip. He told his servants to take care of his work.

Matthew 24:45

Who then is the faithful and wise servant, whom the master has put in charge of the servants in his household to give them their food at the proper time?

When will all Christians go to be with Jesus?

12. We will go to be with him when he comes again. But not everyone may be ready when he comes.

1 John 2:28

And now, dear children, continue in him, so that when he appears we may be confident and unashamed before him at his coming.

If a servant becomes careless and sinful, then there is trouble when the master comes.

A servant of God should be faithful all the time. He should always be ready. He should not work only when he thinks Jesus is coming.

Why has God not told us when Jesus will come again?

13. God has not told us because he wants us to be ready all the time. Jesus will come suddenly. Then he will find the servants which are faithful and will reward them.

Revelation 22:12

Behold, I am coming soon! My reward is with me, and I will give to everyone according to what he has done.

How would Jesus find your life and work if he came today?

14. When will all Christians go to be with Jesus?

WEEK 10: THE BLESSINGS OF FOLLOWING JESUS
DAY 4: BE READY FOR THE RETURN OF JESUS

1. When will all Christians go to be with Jesus?

Why has God not told us when Jesus will return?

2. We will go to live with Jesus when he returns. God has not told us when this will happen. This is because he wants us to be ready all the time. But how can we be ready?

1 Thessalonians 4:14,17

We believe that Jesus died and rose again and so we believe that God will bring with Jesus those who have fallen asleep in him. . . . After that, we who are still alive and are left will be caught up with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And so we will be with the Lord forever.

This is what we will learn today.

- 1) We must be obedient.
- 2) We must live a holy life.

If we really love Jesus we will be obedient and live a holy life until he returns.

How would you feel if Jesus came back and you were not ready?

3. Let me tell you something which happened. I know this is true, because I have visited in the house where it happened.

The man who owned the house was a government leader. One time he had to go away for three weeks with his family. He asked his servant to stay at the house and care for it. The servant would receive extra money for this.

The owner of the house left. The servant thought, "Now I will have a good time!" He invited many of his friends and had a party in his boss's house. Some of his friends became drunk. They stayed all night and used the beds. The servant didn't wash the dishes or the sheets. He thought the owner would not come back for two more weeks. So he went to visit some of his friends in the villages.

Did the servant obey what his boss told him to do?

4. This servant did not obey. He did not care for the house. He left the house and he went to visit his friends. He wore his boss's best suit. In the villages he got drunk with his friends. Soon he couldn't walk and on the way home he fell in the mud.

The next morning he saw that the suit was dirty. He decided to wash the suit. He also wanted to wash the dishes, the sheets, and clean the house. But just then he heard a car outside. He ran to the window. With great surprise, he saw his boss getting out of the car. It was too late to do his work. He had been found unfaithful and he was sent away in shame.

What had the servant failed to do about his boss's words?

5. He did not obey. He didn't do what his boss told him to do. If a servant wants to be faithful, he must obey his master.

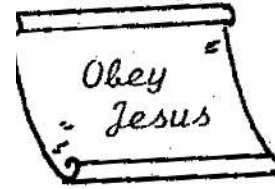
Jesus is our master. He is coming to earth again. He has given us work to do while he is gone. Let us see this verse again.

Revelation 22:12

Behold, I am coming soon! My reward is with me, and I will give to everyone according to what he has done.

Who should obey the commands of Jesus to be ready for his return?

6. We should obey Jesus all the time. We do not want the Master to come and find us unprepared. Take your Bible now and read Matthew 24:42 to 44.



To be ready for his return, what should we do about the things Jesus told us?

7. We must obey. We should do all the things Jesus has told us.

1 Timothy 6:11,12,14

But you, man of God, flee from all this, and pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, endurance and gentleness. Fight the good fight of faith. Take hold of the eternal life to which you were called when you made your good confession in the presence of many witnesses. . . . to keep this commandment without spot or blame until the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ,

What is one reason why we should always obey the commands of Jesus?

8. Jesus is coming again. He wants to find us prepared.

1 John 2:28

And now, dear children, continue in him, so that when he appears we may be confident and unashamed before him at his coming.

John 15:10

If you obey my commands, you will remain in my love, just as I have obeyed my Father's commands and remain in his love.

What should we do to be faithful and ready when Jesus comes again?

9. We must be obedient. We must also live a holy life. If we really love Jesus, we will be obedient and live a holy life when he returns.

1 John 3:2,3

Dear friends, now we are children of God, and what we will be has not yet been made known. But we know that when he appears, we shall be like him, for we shall see him as he is. Everyone who has this hope in him purifies himself, just as he is pure.

What kind of people does God want us to be?

10. He wants us to be holy people. The Bible says that we cannot see God unless we are holy.

Hebrews 12:14

Make every effort to live in peace with all men and to be holy; without holiness no one will see the Lord.

Revelation 21:27

Nothing impure will ever enter it, nor will anyone who does what is shameful or deceitful, but only those whose names are written in the Lamb's book of life.

Can we see God if we do not live a holy life?

11. We must live a holy life to see God. To be holy means to be clean and set apart for God. It means to be doing what God wants us to do. Nothing which is dirty and sinful can enter heaven. We should live a pure and clean life. We should confess all sin and leave it.

1 John 1:9

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.

How can we be made clean and holy?

12. We can be made clean and holy by confessing our sin to God. We want to live a holy life because we expect to see Jesus as he is. Jesus is pure and clean. He is holy.

1 Peter 1:15,16

But just as he who called you is holy, so be holy in all you do; for it is written: "Be holy, because I am holy."

We have learned two things we should be doing while we wait for Jesus to return. What are the two things?

13. We should be obedient and live a holy life. We must do this all the time. We cannot do this by ourselves. We need the Holy Spirit to fill and control us. We want Jesus to be pleased with us when he returns. But Jesus will not be pleased with some of his servants.

Mark 8:38

If anyone is ashamed of me and my words in this adulterous and sinful generation, the Son of Man will be ashamed of him when he comes in his Father's glory with the holy angels.

There are two things we must do to be ready when Jesus comes. The first is to be obedient.

What is the second?

14. We must live a holy life. We must be clean and set apart for God to use. All believers should be prepared for his return. Paul is writing to all of us in this verse.

2 Corinthians 5:10

For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may receive what is due him for the things done while in the body, whether good or bad.

What is the first thing we must do to be ready when Jesus comes?

2) We must live a holy life.

15. We must be obedient. When Jesus comes all believers will go to be with him. Each believer will answer for the way he lived and served the Lord Jesus.

1 Corinthians 3:13-15

His work will be shown for what it is, because the Day will bring it to light. It will be revealed with fire, and the fire will test the quality of each man's work. If what he has built survives, he will receive his reward. If it is burned up, he will suffer loss; he himself will be saved, but only as one escaping through the flames.

How should we be living when Jesus comes?

1) We must be obedient.

2)

16. We must live a holy life.

Some people start out in the way of Jesus. They are born again. They follow Jesus closely for awhile and then become careless. They forget that Jesus is coming again. They are not obeying the things that Jesus told us to do. They do not keep their lives clean. They will be unprepared and ashamed.

1 Corinthians 15:58

*Therefore, my dear brothers, stand firm.
Let nothing move you.
Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord,
because you know that your labor
in the Lord is not in vain.*

We can be ready when Jesus comes. We can look forward to his coming with joy.
