#### LESSON 10

#### SYNOPTIC GOSPELS

Synoptic means to tell about the same things in much the same way and in much the same order they happened.

The first three Gospels Matthew, Mark and Luke — are called synoptic Gospels. The synoptic Gospels tell about Jesus Christ. The synoptic Gospels tell in a similar order what Jesus did. The synoptic Gospels tell similar things that Jesus did. Yet, each Gospel tells about Jesus Christ in its own way. The stories are the same in these Gospels, but are told in different ways.

God let the writers of the Gospels write in their own way. Yet, God told them what to write. By doing this, God gave a better and a more complete picture of what Jesus Christ is like.

The Gospel of John is different from the other Gospels. It tells other things about Jesus. The Gospel of John shows Jesus Christ as God. The other Gospels show Jesus Christ as man.

## Example.




#### CHARTS




These charts will help you find things in the Gospels.








Luke has the most parables. Luke has 21 parables. Matthew has 17. The rest

of the Gospels have a few. Luke is made up of very short stories. They are almost like pictures taken with a camera. The other Gospels have longer stories. Matthew gives the sermon on the mount in three chapters and Luke gives it in 29 verses.

The story of the rich man and Lazarus is not really a parable. Jesus says, "There was ..." These verses say it really happened. Jesus used the name of a man. This story shows what hell is like.
