INTRODUCTION TO REVELATION

The writer of Revelation

The book of Revelation was given from God. It was given to us through Jesus Christ. Jesus Christ sent the message to John through an angel (Revelation 1:1). This book was commanded to be written (Revelation 1:11).

The full name of the book of Revelation is "The Revelation of Jesus Christ." Some Bibles add "as written by John." This John is John the Beloved.

John used the language of his time to describe things which will happen in the future. He used words he knew to describe things that were strange to him. He had never seen things like aeroplanes, satellites, or missiles. John turned around because he wanted to see who told him to write. When he looked at Jesus, and recognized Him, he was told again to write.

Why Revelation was written

Revelation means to take off the veil, or to take off the cover. When the cover is taken off, that which is inside can be seen. When a person reveals something, he shows it as it is.


Revelation shows that which was, that which is, and that which will be hereafter (Revelation 1:19). Revelation shows Jesus Christ in all His glory. Revelation shows what the churches were like when John wrote. Revelation also shows what would happen after John wrote.

To whom the book was written

The book of Revelation was written to the churches in Asia. It is also written for all Christians.

Where and when the book was written

John was on the island of Patmos. (You can find Patmos on the map below.) He was held a prisoner there. He was on this island because he preached about Jesus Christ (Revelation 1:9). This is believed to be during the time Dominican was ruler in Rome. Many Christians were persecuted because they would not pray to the emperor (ruler) in Rome. The book was written between 80 and 100 A.D.



Why Revelation should be studied

- 1) Revelation should be studied because it is a revelation. It shows what is happening and what will happen.
- 2) The book is not closed but is open for all to read.
- 3) A blessing is promised to those who read it those who read it alone and those who read it aloud in the church (Revelation 1:3).
- 4) The word pictures in Revelation have been used in the Bible before. The meanings of new word pictures are given.

How people understand Revelation

There are four different ways in which people understand the book of Revelation.

- 1) The **preterist group** believes it all happened in the past. To them Revelation was only for the time in which it was written. It does not have meaning for today.
- 2) The **idealist** or **spiritual group** believes that Revelation is a picture of the fight between good and evil. Good being the Christians and evil being those who have nothing to do with God.
- 3) The **historist group** believes that Revelation shows what happened and will happen in the world. For example: They say that the seven churches described in Revelation chapters 2 and 3 picture different periods of time. These periods of time are from Pentecost until Christ returns.
- 4) The **futurist group** believes that the things in Revelation chapters 2 and 3 happened when the book was written and the things in chapters 4 to 22 will happen in the future. They believe much of Revelation will happen just before Jesus Christ sets up the 1,000 year kingdom.

In this lesson we will not attempt to tell what each thing means. We want to see what is in the book of Revelation.

Revelation 1:1-20

READ Revelation 1:1-20.

Jesus Christ is the center of the book of Revelation. Revelation reveals Jesus Christ. It is the testimony of Jesus Christ (Revelation 1:2).

In the first chapter of Revelation we see Christ Jesus in His glory. The Lord God is the first and the last.

Jesus Christ is seen standing among the seven lampstands. He wore a long robe reaching down to His feet and a golden sash around His chest. His hair was white as wool, or white as snow. His eyes were like blazing fire. His feet were like bronze glowing in a furnace. His voice sounded like rushing waters. In His right hand He held seven stars. His face was like the sun shining with all its brightness.

Jesus said, "I am the Living One; I was dead, and behold, I am alive for ever and ever!"

NAMES OF JESUS AS USED IN REVELATION

Jesus Christ is called by different names. Revelation tells who He is. Let us look at a number of these names.

Book of the Lamb

All inhabitants of the earth will worship the beast - all whose names have not been written in the book of life belonging to the Lamb.

Revelation 13:8

Nothing impure will ever enter it, nor will anyone who does what is shameful or deceitful, but only those whose names are written in the Lamb's book of life.

Revelation 21:27

We find a number of praises in Revelation: the song of the living creatures, the song of the elders, the praise from the angels, the praises from great multitudes of people, the song of Moses, the song at the marriage feast of the Lamb, and also praises when some of the judgments were to be carried out.

Though many judgments are pronounced in Revelation and it describes a time of tribulation like there has never been on earth before, the book has many songs of praise and adoration.

All the songs show the worship and adoration which is given to Jesus, the Lamb of God. He is "worthy" because of His sacrifice for sin, because He is the Son of God, and because He is God.

God is spoken of as "holy" in the songs and praises, either in direct expression or by implication. He is just in His judgments.

Glory and honor are given to Jesus Christ by the living creatures, the elders, the angels, the multitudes on earth, and by those who have been redeemed.

These songs and praises are in great contrast to the words of those who do not fear God during the tribulation time. In spite of all the hard times and suffering, most people do not repent nor worship Christ. Revelation 9:20,21 describes this very well:

The rest of mankind that were not killed by these plagues still did not repent of the work of their hands; they did not stop worshiping demons, and idols of gold, silver, bronze, stone and wood - idols that cannot see or hear or walk. Nor did they repent of their murders, their magic arts, their sexual immorality or their thefts.

Praise from living creatures

"Holy, holy, holy is the Lord God Almighty, who was, and is, and is to come."

Revelation 4:8

Praise from living creatures

"You are worthy, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor and power, for you created all things, and by your will they were created and have their being."

Revelation 4:11

Elders and angels worship

"Amen! Praise and glory and wisdom and thanks and honor and power and strength be to our God for ever and ever. Amen!"

Revelation 7:12

Song of many angels

"Worthy is the Lamb, who was slain, to receive power and wealth and wisdom and strength and honor and glory and praise!"

Revelation 2:1-3:22

READ Revelation 2:1-3:22.

In this part are seven letters written to seven churches in Asia. Each letter is addressed to a specific church which existed in the time John lived. In these letters Jesus Christ tells the churches five different things.

- 1) Jesus, the sender of the messages is described in a different way to each church. The character of the sender meets the need for each church.
- 2) He tells them the good things they are doing, and gives them praise for these.
- 3) He tells them the sins they are doing.
- 4) He gives a warning to those who are sinning by telling them what will happen if they keep on sinning.
- 5) Jesus also gives a promise to all who overcome the tests and temptations.

Revelation 2:1-7

Ephesus

Worshipped goddess Diana

Message sent by

He who holds the seven stars in His right hand and walks among the seven golden lampstands.

Praise

Jesus knows:

- 1) their deeds.
- 2) their hard work.
- 3) their perseverance.
- 4) they cannot tolerate wicked men.
- 5) they have tested those who claim to be apostles but are not, and have found them false.
- 6) they have persevered and have endured hardships for Jesus' name, and have not grown weary.
- 7) they hate the practices of the Nicolaitans.

Sin

They have forsaken their first love.

Warning

Remember the height from which they have fallen!

Repent and do the things they did at first.

If they do not repent:

Jesus will come to them and remove their lampstand from its place.

Promise to overcomer

To him Jesus will give the right to eat from the tree of life, which is in the paradise of God.

Meaning or history

Myrrh

Message sent by

The First and the Last, who died and came to life again

Praise

Jesus knows:

- 1) their afflictions and their poverty yet they are rich!
- 2) the slander of those who say they are Jews and are not, but are a synagogue of Satan.

Jesus encourages them not to be afraid of what they are about to suffer. The devil will put some of them in prison to test them and they will suffer persecution for ten days.

Warning					

Promise to overcomer

Those who are faithful, even to the point of death:

- 1) Jesus will give them the crown of life.
- 2) They will not be hurt at all by the second death.

Revelation 2:12-17

Church

Pergamum

Meaning or history

The city where parchment or pergamena was first made

Message sent by

He who has the sharp, double-edged sword

Praise

Jesus knows:

- 1) they live where Satan has his throne, yet they remain true to Jesus' name.
- 2) they did not renounce their faith in Jesus, even in the days of Antipas, Jesus' faithful witness, who was put to death in their city.

Sin

They have:

- 1) people there who hold to the teaching of Balaam, who taught Balak to entice the Israelites to sin by eating food sacrificed to idols and by committing sexual immorality.
- 2) those who hold to the teaching of the Nicolaitans.

Promise to overcomer

Jesus will give

- 1) some of the hidden manna.
- 2) to the one who overcomes a white stone with a new name written on it, known only to him who receives it.

Warning

Repent therefore! Otherwise, Jesus will soon come to them and will fight against them with the sword of His mouth.

Revelation 2:18-29

Church

Thyatira

Meaning or history

Noted for dying scarlet cloth

Message sent by

The Son of God, whose eyes are like blazing fire and whose feet are like burnished bronze

Praise

Jesus knows:

- 1) their deeds,
- 2) their love and faith
- 3) their service and perseverance
- 4) they are now doing more than they did at first
- 5) those who do not hold to Jezebel's teaching and have not learned Satan's so-called deep secrets

Promise to overcomer

Jesus will give to him who overcomes:

- 1) authority over the nations.
- 2) to rule the nations with an iron scepter.
- 3) the morning star.

Sin

They tolerate that woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophetess. By her teaching she misleads Jesus' servants into sexual immorality and the eating of food sacrificed to idols.

Jesus gave Jezebel time to repent of her immorality, but she was unwilling.

Warning

Jesus will cast Jezebel on a bed of suffering, and will make those who commit adultery with her suffer intensely, unless they repent of her ways. Jesus will strike her children dead.

Jesus is He who searches hearts and minds, and will repay each of them according to their deeds.

Hold on to what they have until Jesus comes.

Revelation 3:1-6

Church

Sardis

Meaning or history

Textile manufacturing and jewel making

Message sent by

He who holds the seven spirits of God and the seven stars

Praise

They have a few people in Sardis who have not soiled their clothes.

Sin

Jesus knows their deeds; they have a reputation of being alive, but they are dead.

Promise to overcomer

The few people in Sardis who have not soiled their clothes will walk with Jesus, dressed in white, for they are worthy.

Jesus will never blot out their names from the book of life, but will acknowledge their names before His Father and His Father's angels.

Warning

Wake up and strengthen what remains and is about to die, for Jesus has not found their deeds complete in the sight of His God.

Remember what they have received and heard; to obey it, and to repent.

If they will not repent: Jesus will come like a thief.

Revelation 3:7-13

Church

Meaning or history

Philadelphia

Brotherly love

Message sent by

He who is holy and true, who holds the key of David. What He opens no one can shut, and what He shuts, no one can open.

Praise

Jesus knows:

- 1) their deeds.
- 2) they have little strength, yet they have kept His word and have not denied His name.

Jesus has placed before them an open door that no one can shut.

They have kept Jesus' command to endure patiently.

Sin

Warning

Jesus is coming soon. They must hold on to what they have, so no one will take their crown.

Promise to overcomer

Jesus will make those who are of the synagogue of Satan, who claim to be Jews though they are not, but are liars, come and fall down at their feet and acknowledge that Jesus has loved them.

Jesus will also keep them from the hour of trial that is going to come upon the whole world to test those who live on the earth.

Jesus will make them pillars in temple of His God. Never again will he leave the temple.

Jesus will write on him the name of His God and the name of the city of His God, the new Jerusalem, which is coming down out of heaven from His God. Jesus will also write on them His new name.

Laodicea

Meaning or history

Named after Laodice, the wife of Antiochus II who rebuilt the city

Tales

Warning

Jesus counsels them to buy from Him gold refined in the fire, so they can become rich; to have white clothes to wear and so they can cover their shameful nakedness; and to have salve to put on their eyes so they can see.

Those whom Jesus loves, He rebukes and disciplines. Therefore they should be earnest and repent.

Jesus says, "Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with him, and he with me."

Sin

Jesus knows their deeds, that they are neither cold nor hot. He wishes they were either one or the other! Because they are lukewarm - neither hot nor cold - He is about to spit them out of His mouth.

They say, "I am rich; I have acquired wealth and do not need a thing."

They do not realize that they are wretched, pitiful, poor, blind and naked.

Promise to overcomer

Jesus will give the right to sit with Him on His throne, just as Jesus overcame and sat down with His Father on His throne.

HEREAFTER

Revelation 4:1-22:21

READ Revelation 4:1-22:21

Chapter four opens the third part of the book of Revelation. This part tells what will happen in the future.

Rapture

Rapture means to "seize and carry away." The rapture of the Church means that Christ is coming to take the Church to heaven. Christ will come in a cloud. The believers who died will be raised and meet Him in the air. The believers who live on earth will also meet Him in the air (1 Corinthians 15:51-54; John 14:3).

There are three ideas as to when the rapture will take place.

1) After the tribulation (post-tribulation)

Some people believe the Church will go through the tribulation time and then will be taken to heaven. They use Matthew 24:21,22 for their reason to believe this way.

2) During the tribulation (mid-tribulation)

Some people believe the Church will go through the first 3 ½ years of the tribulation. They believe that at the middle of the tribulation the Church will be taken to heaven. They use Matthew 24:21,22 as reasons for believing as they do.

3) Before the tribulation (pre-tribulation)

Many people believe the Church will be taken to heaven before the tribulation starts. They use Matthew 24:21; 1 Thessalonians 5:9; and 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18 for the reasons they believe as they do.

These people also believe Revelation chapters 4 and 5 show the Church with Christ in heaven during the tribulation.

They believe in a second rapture when the believers who died during the tribulation will be taken up and take part with the Church in the Marriage Supper of the Lamb (Revelation 7:9-17; 19:1-10).

Tribulation

Tribulation means great "suffering." When we talk about the tribulation time, we talk about the great suffering before Jesus Christ sets up His kingdom on earth. For some this time of tribulation began at the ascension of Christ. For others the tribulation time is seven years (Daniel 9:27), divided into two parts, each part three and one half years (Revelation 12:14; Daniel chapter 12).

Millennium

Millennium means a time of one thousand years.

The people who believe that Jesus Christ will come to take the believers to heaven at the rapture and that there will be a time of tribulation before the 1,000 year time of peace are called premillennialists. The millennium is the time when Jesus Christ will rule one thousand years on earth. During this time Satan will be tied up in the bottomless pit (Revelation 20:1-3; Isaiah chapters 11 and 12).

Another group, called the amillennialists, does not believe there will be a long time of peace before the end of the world. They believe God's millennial rule is found in the hearts of people. They believe good and evil will grow together until Jesus Christ returns to raise the dead and to judge all people.

The Last Battle


After the millennium Satan will be let loose. He will deceive many people. Satan and his followers will make war with Jesus Christ but Christ will win the war and Satan will be thrown into the Lake of Fire (Revelation 20:7-10).


The White Throne Judgment


Christ will take His place on the white throne. The dead who did not believe in Christ will be raised to life. They will have to stand in front of Christ. Books and the book of life will be opened. Christ will judge all those people. Those whose names are not written in the book of life will be thrown into the Lake of Fire (Revelation 20:11-15; Philippians 2:5-11).

New Heaven and New Earth

After the judgment, the old heaven will pass away (2 Peter 3:10,11). A new earth and new heaven will be made (Revelation chapter 21).








EARTH


Chapters 15 and 16 tell of the last plagues which will come upon the earth.
